**Swimming Y2?**

They will be taught by school staff along with swimming teacher Ms Townsend. Children will require their swimwear (no bikinis please) and towels every week. Please ensure that your child has warm clothes for walking to and from the pool. They may also want to bring a drink of water and some fruit or bread. We require a note if your child will not be swimming for any reason. Please talk to class teachers if you can assist with walking to/from the pool.

Parents are invited to our Swimming Gala when KS2 pupils will be competing during the morning of Thursday 19<sup>th</sup> July. We request that only photos of your own child may be taken at this event.

It is a very exciting afternoon for the children and we dread the thought of it raining. If we have to cancel we will send a text in the morning. Monday 25<sup>th</sup> June is our back up date.

Pupils will need a water bottle and can wear a red, yellow, green or blue T-shirt to help distinguish their team colour. It would be wise to send your child to school with a hat and sunscreen and any large umbrellas/sunshades/gazebos would be appreciated. We recommend spectators bringing their own seats or picnic rugs as well as some change to purchase P.T.A. refreshments.

This is particularly important for Foundation Stage pupils who spend a lot of time learning outdoors. A clearly labelled bottle of **water** is also a good idea.
